

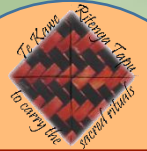

Making Techniques and Skills a Priority Fr Anthony Malone OFM

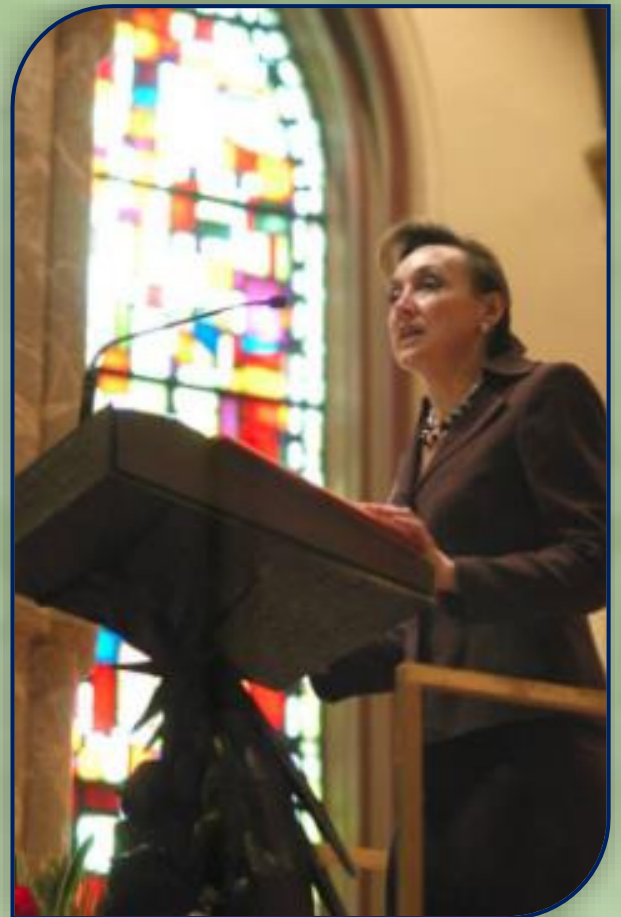
Fr Anthony, an expert in techniques and skills associated with speaking, will take us on a journey of discovery as we explore and use a variety of breathing and vocal exercises.
