



Transporting Children and Vulnerable Adults



As a general rule:

- A child or vulnerable adult should only be transported with specific permission from their parent/caregiver.
- In the event that a child or vulnerable adult needs to be transported, the 'two adult rule' applies.
- Alternatively, if two adults are not available to provide transport, children may be transported in instances where there will be no fewer than two children in the vehicle at all times.
- All people travelling in a vehicle must wear seat belts, the driver should be appropriately licensed and the vehicle should be registered, warranted and safe to drive.
