Feijoa muffins

Ingredients:

Serves: 12

220g feijoa flesh (about 7-8 feijoas)

1 lemon - zest and juice

½ cup melted butter

1 tsp vanilla essence

1 egg

½ cup brown sugar

½ cup dessicated coconut

1½ cups flour

3 tsp baking powder



Directions:

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C.
2. Scoop out the flesh of the feijoas into a medium sized bowl and mash roughly with a fork.
3. Add, oil, egg, juice and zest of lemon, and vanilla to the mashed feijoa. Combine well with a whisk or fork.
4. In a second larger bowl, combine the dry ingredients: flour, baking powder, brown sugar and coconut. Do this with a whisk to ensure they are combined and any lumps of brown sugar or coconut are broken up.
5. Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients and gently combine with a wooden spoon or spatula to make the feijoa muffin batter.
6. Spoon the feijoa muffin batter into a 12 portion muffin tin lined with greaseproof baking cases.
7. optional extra: scoop the flesh from a couple of feijoas and slice thinly. Gently push into the top of the muffin and sprinkle with a little brown sugar.
8. Bake at 180 degrees for approximately 25 minutes

Bacon and egg pies

The crust on these filling bacon and egg pies are made with bread. This is a perfect brunch, light lunch or lunch box filler.

Ingredients:

Vegetable oil spray
1 onion, diced
4 rashers bacon, diced
6 slices wholemeal bread, crusts removed
4 eggs
1/3 cup milk
2 tbsp flat-parsley, chopped



Directions:

Preparation: 30min

1. Preheat oven to 180°C or 160°C fan-forced. Spray a 6-cup Texas muffin tin with oil and set aside.
2. Spray oil in a frying pan; over medium heat, cook the onion and bacon until the onion is translucent.
3. Push the bread into the muffin tin and spoon in the bacon and onion mixture.
4. In a bowl, whisk together egg, milk and parsley and distribute evenly into the 6 muffin tins.
5. Bake for 20 minutes. Leave to sit for 3 mins before running a knife around the edges. Serve.

Notes:

- When pouring in the egg mixture into the tins, it will overflow and then absorb down into the bread. It seems like it is too much but then it settles and you add the rest.
- Make these muffins more scrumptious by adding a little grated cheese on the top.
- Use your favourite bread. Crunchy multigrain is fab for the great texture it brings.

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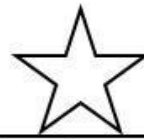

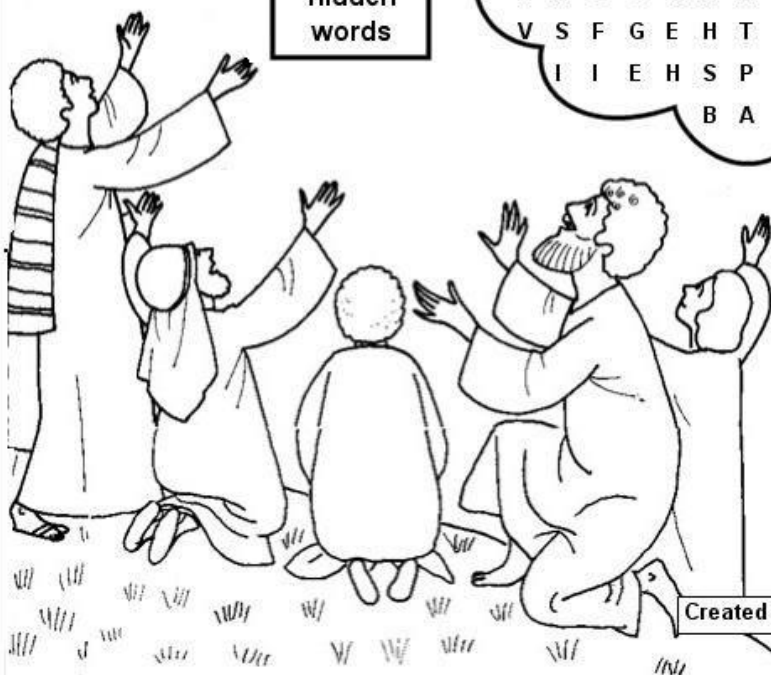
