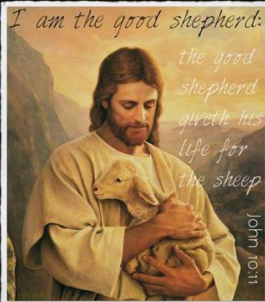

crowd of people. There must have been 5,000!

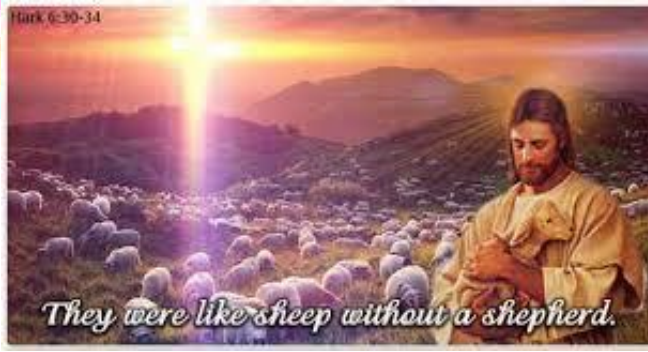
Jesus felt really sorry for them.

Jesus talked to them for a long time.



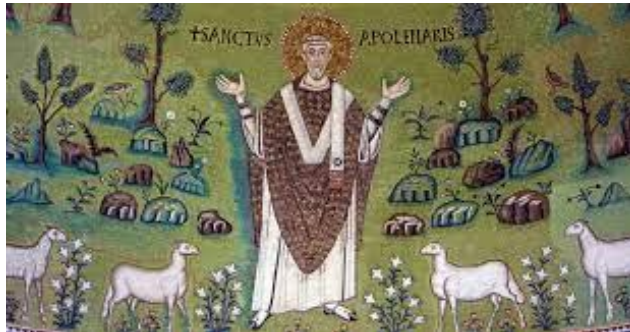

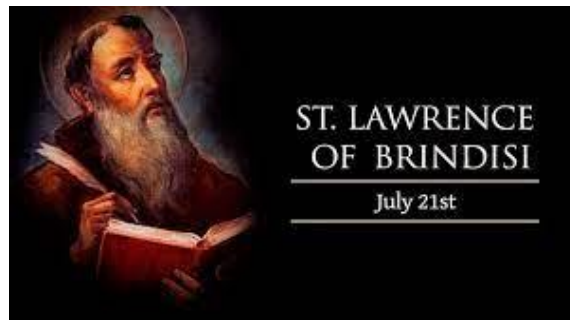

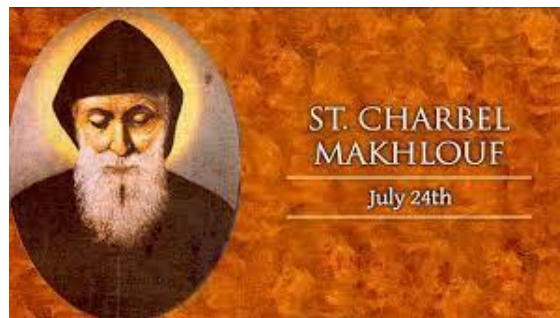

# Cheese rolls

## Ingredients:

- 1 small onion, finely chopped
- 1 packet onion soup mix, we used Maggi
- 375ml evaporated milk
- ¼ cup cream
- 1 tsp mustard powder
- 2 cups grated cheese (be generous)
- ½ lemon, zest and juice
- 1 sprinkle grated nutmeg
- 1 loaf white sandwich bread, sliced
- 1 knob butter, melted to brush rolls



## Directions:

1. In a saucepan mix together onion, onion soup mix, evaporated milk, cream, mustard powder, grated cheese, lemon zest, a grind of black pepper and a grate of nutmeg.
2. Gently heat and stir to melt cheese and thicken.
3. Remove from heat, add the lemon juice and leave to cool 5 minutes.
4. Generously spread on to slices of fresh white bread.
5. Roll into thirds, brush with butter and toast in a sandwich maker (set so it doesn't squash them), until golden and just bursting. You can also bake them in the oven, seam side down.



# Red velvet cupcakes

## Ingredients:

**Makes: 18 cupcakes**

**1 cup flour**  
**1 tablespoon cocoa powder**  
 **$\frac{3}{4}$  cup sugar**  
 **$\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon baking soda**  
**Pinch of salt**  
**60g butter**  
**1 egg**  
**1 teaspoon vanilla essence**  
**50ml cooking oil**  
**Red food colouring**

**For decorating: icing,  
fondant**



## Directions:

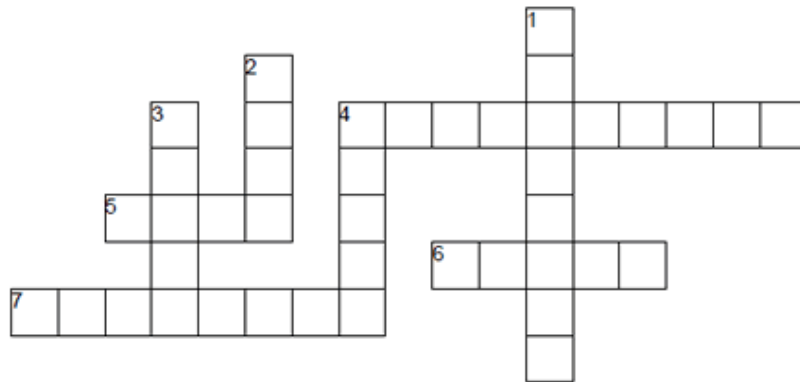
1. Preheat oven to 180°C.
2. Prepare muffin tins by lining with baking cups - you can even find heart shaped cupcake liners like we used!
3. Mix together the flour, cocoa powder, baking soda, and salt.
4. Using a mixer, mix the butter and sugar on medium speed for a few minutes, until smooth.
5. Add the egg, oil, vanilla, and food colouring - continue mixing until smooth.
6. Alternate adding the dry ingredients and milk, mixing until just combined.
7. Divide the mixture between your baking cups and bake for 15 minutes at 180°C or until a toothpick or fork comes out dry.
8. Once cooled, top with your favourite icing. You can have fun decorating by drawing hearts or a cute message! We used fondant to create cute hearts.
