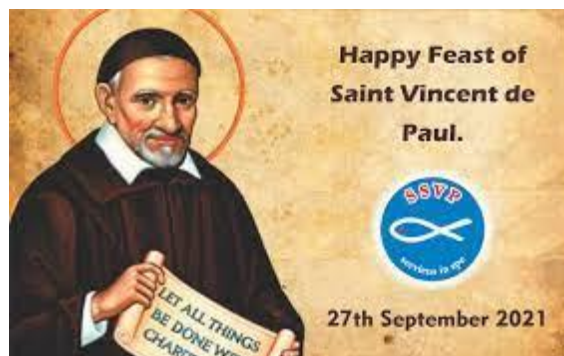

Mike's Yellow Vegetable Curry from Scratch (GF)

Ingredients

Grapeseed oil - 2 Tbsp
Butternut squash or crown pumpkin - 350 g
Courgettes – 3
Red capsicum - 1 large
Fresh spinach leaves - 130 g
Coconut cream - 1 can
Water
Salt to season
Frozen peas - 1 cup
Brown sugar - 2 Tbsp
Juice of 1 lemon
Mint leaves - 1 cup
Coriander leaves - 1 cup
Thai fish sauce - 3 Tbsp
Steamed rice, to serve - 3 cups

Curry paste

Onions, peeled – 2
Garlic cloves, peeled – 6
Lemongrass - 2 stalks
Ginger - 1 knob
Curry powder - 2 Tbsp
Turmeric - 1/2 tsp
Chillies of your choice – 2
Coriander stems, left over from the leaves - 1 cup
Makrut (kaffir) lime leaves (optional) – 5

- For the curry paste, prepare all the ingredients and blend together until smooth in a blender or smash in a pestle and mortar.
- Heat a cast iron fry-pan or pot and add in the oil. Add in one cup of the yellow curry paste and fry over a medium heat until the paste becomes fragrant.
- Whilst frying the paste, prepare the vegetables. Cut the butternut in half and then peel each half before removing the seeds. Cut into large dice.
- Dice the courgettes into a large dice along with the red peppers and roughly chop the spinach. Set aside.
- Add the coconut cream to the yellow curry paste along with a can full of water. Season with a pinch of salt. Bring it to the boil and then add in the prepared vegetables and frozen peas. Simmer for a further 10 minutes before checking the tenderness of the butternut.
- Once cooked, add in the sugar, Thai fish sauce, lemon juice and finally the mint and coriander leaves.
- Serve with steamed rice.



Mike's Cashew and Crystalized Ginger Bliss Balls (GF)

Ingredients

Cashew nuts - 1 cup

Walnuts - 1/2 cup

Dates - 1 1/2 cups

Raisins - 1/2 cup

Dried apricots - 1/2 cup

Peanut butter - 1 Tbsp

Crystalized ginger - 3 squares

Water - 1 Tbsp

Desiccated coconut - 1 cup

Method

- Place the cashew nuts, walnuts, dates, raisins, apricots, peanut butter and crystallised ginger into a blender and blitz until smooth.
- Add water and blend again until the mixture comes together.
- Roll into balls to your desired size and place onto a tray. Refrigerate for 15 minutes to set.
- Remove the balls and roll through the coconut until well coated.
- Store in a airtight container in the fridge for up to 10 days.
