“Leave him alone.

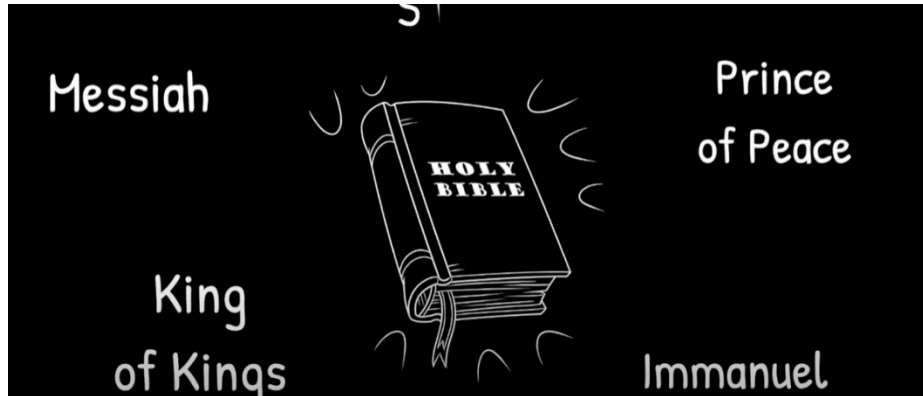
We deserve to be punished, but this man has done

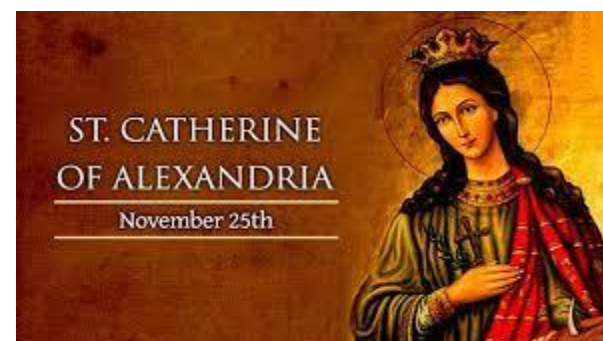

Carrot Mac & Cheese Bites

Ingredients

Extra virgin olive oil - 2 Tbsp
Large brown onion, coarsely grated - 1
Medium carrots, coarsely grated - 3
Plain flour - 1/3 cup
Milk - 3 cups
Grated pizza cheese - 1 cup
Cooked macaroni - 3 cups
Chives, finely chopped - 1 bunch

Method

- Preheat oven to 200°C (180°C fan-forced). Grease a 12-hole, 1/3-cup capacity muffin pan.
- Heat oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Cook onion and carrot for 10 minutes, stirring, or until softened. Sprinkle over the flour, then stir for 1 minute or until combined. Gradually add milk, stirring to combine. Bring to a simmer, then cook for 10 minutes or until the mixture has thickened. Remove pan from heat.
- Fold in cheese, macaroni and 3/4 of the chives until the cheese has melted. Spoon mixture into muffin pan. Sprinkle with half of the remaining chives.
- Bake for 25 minutes or until golden brown. Cool in pan for 10 minutes. Serve topped with remaining chives.



Baked Apple Sponge

Ingredients

Large apples, peeled, cored, chopped - 2

Large pears, peeled, cored, chopped - 2

White sugar - 2 Tbsp

Whole clove - 1

Slice lemon peel - 1

Low-fat spread - 60 g

White sugar - 1/2 cup

Egg - 1

Self-raising flour, sifted - 1 cup

Low-fat milk - 1/2 cup

Ice-cream or cream, to serve.

Method

- Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan-forced).
- To make stewed fruit: Place 1cm water in a saucepan with sugar, clove and lemon peel. Bring to boil, stirring. Add fruit. Cook gently, covered, for about 10 minutes until tender.
- Spoon stewed fruit into the base of a 20cm pie plate or casserole dish.
- In a bowl, beat spread and sugar together until creamy. Add egg, beating well. Lightly fold in flour, alternately with milk. Spread evenly over fruit.
- Bake for 25-30 minutes, until top is firm and golden. Serve warm with ice-cream or cream.
