And at once they left their nets and followed him

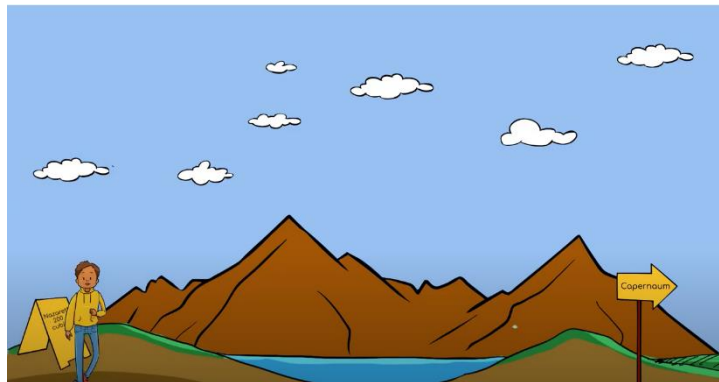
Going on from there he saw another pair of brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John; they were in their boat with their father Zebedee, mending their nets, and he called them.

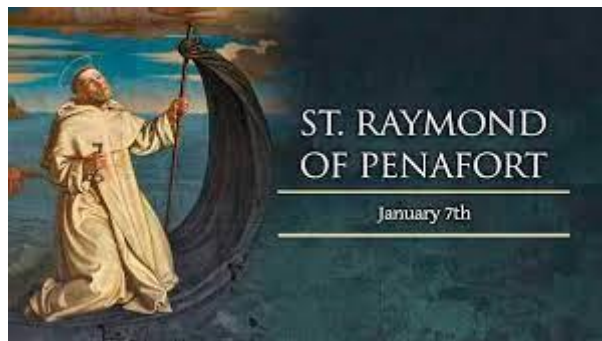

Kumara, Avocado & Egg Salad

Ingredients

Olive oil - 2 Tbsp
Medium size kumara, thinly sliced - 2
Bread slices, cut into cubes - 2
Lettuce, shredded - 3 cups
Avocado, diced - 1
Egg, boiled and halved - 4
Italian parsley, chopped - 1/2 cup

Dressing

Aioli - 1/2 cup
Natural yoghurt - 1/4 cup
Chipotle sauce - 1 Tbsp
Lemon juice - 1 Tbsp
fresh produce lemons ,
per kg loose



Method

- Preheat an oven to 180°C (160°C fan forced).
- Place the kumara onto an oven tray. Drizzle with the olive oil and bake for 20-25 minutes until crisp and golden.
- Halfway through cooking, add the bread cubes to the oven on another tray. Once done, remove both trays and allow to cool.
- To make the dressing, combine the aioli, yoghurt, chipotle and lemon juice.
- Into a large bowl, place the lettuce, avocado, chopped eggs, kumara and croutons. Drizzle with the dressing and toss to serve.

Passionfruit & lemon polenta biscuits

INGREDIENTS

- 150g dairy-free spread
- 2 tsp lemon rind, finely grated
- $\frac{2}{3}$ cup pure icing sugar, sifted
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup polenta
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ cups gluten-free plain flour, sifted
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup pure icing sugar, sifted
- 2 tsp fresh passionfruit pulp
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp water

METHOD

1. Preheat oven to 180°C /160°C fan-forced. Whisk dairy free spread, lemon rind and icing sugar together until creamy. Stir through polenta and flour and mix into a soft dough. Roll mixture into small balls. Place biscuits on to baking paper lined tray and flatten slightly.
2. Bake for 15-18 minutes until firm. Remove from oven and stand on tray for 5 minutes. Remove to rack and cool. Spread with or dollop over icing and set aside until firm.
3. *For icing:* Mix passionfruit pulp and water into icing sugar to make a soft icing.

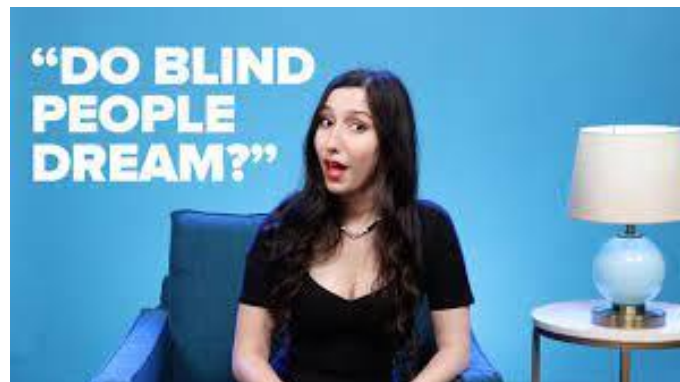

Jesus replied to Simon, "Don't be afraid! From now on you'll be fishing for people!" Luke 5:10b (NLT)

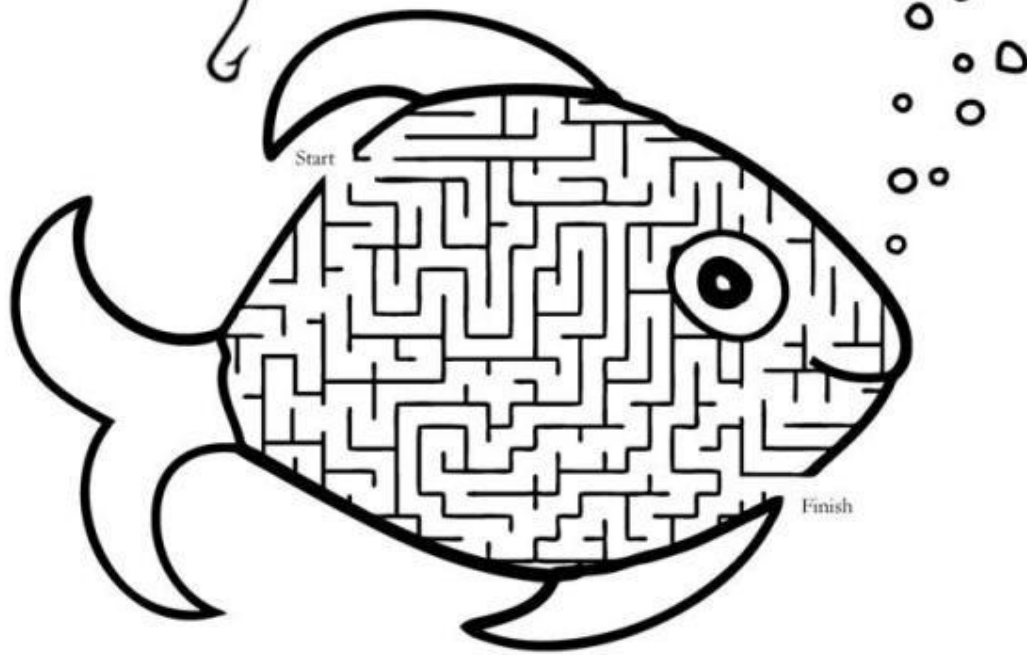

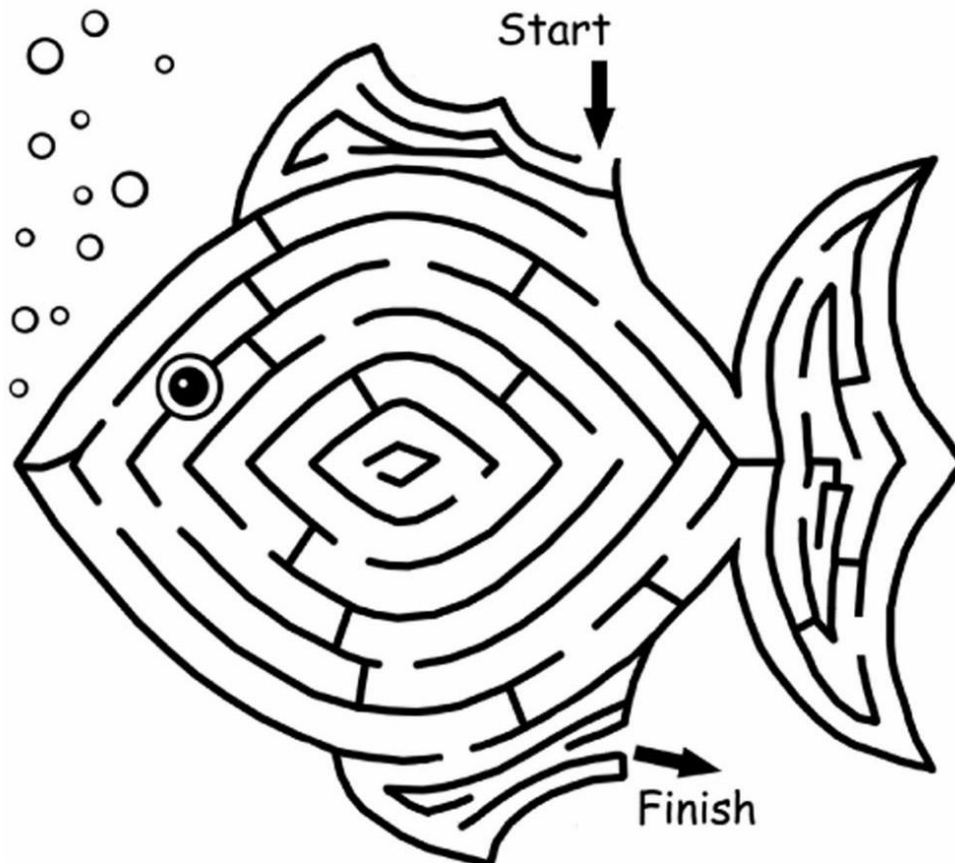

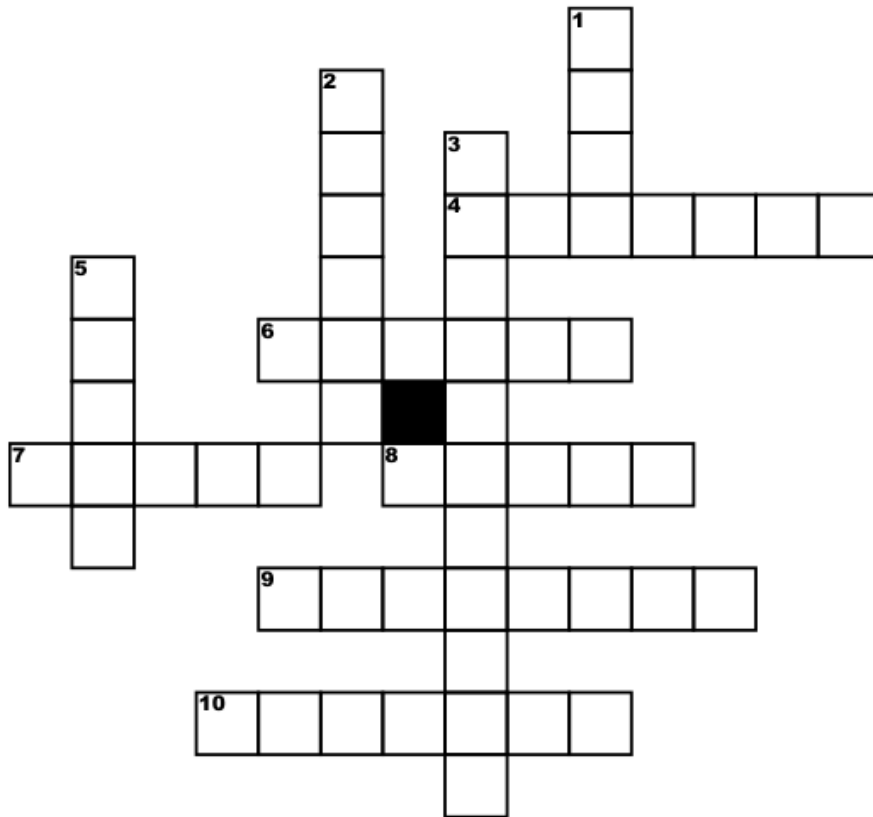
