Parish Safeguarding reviews

Parish Safeguarding reviews are now almost completed. To date we have completed 56 reviews. We recently travelled to the Far North West Coast, Mid North, Whangarei and Dargaville parishes. We are grateful for the manaakitanga extended to us by all and for the reasonable weather we experienced, just making it home before the deluge.

Below is a list of some common recommendations from the reviews:

- Standard 1: Create a Safeguarding notice board
- Standard 2: Changes to confessionals to preclude priest from penitent and increase in visibility
- Standard 3: Nominate a parish complaints/ feedback person
- Standard 4: Ministry groups to meet to review safe practices
- Standard 5: Ongoing workshops for newly recruited volunteers. Roll out of Volunteer agreements.

Thank you to all those parishes who have provided updates on how the implementation of recommendations are going.

The plan is the parish sends an update 6 months post review and then annually. I will send out reminders when your parish is due.
