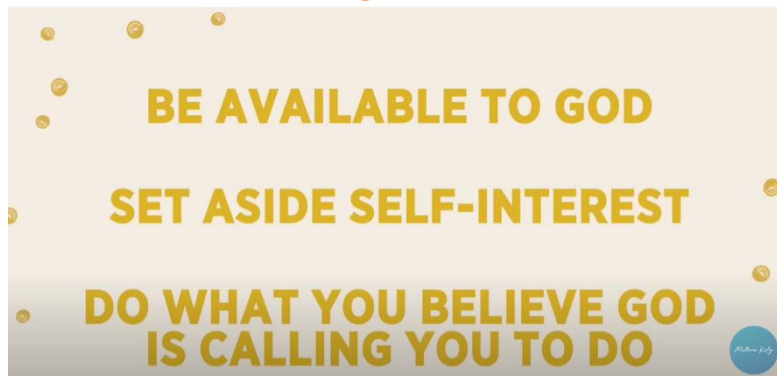

Kūmara, Carrot & Feta Fritters

Ingredients

Large orange kūmara, grated - 1
Medium carrot, grated - 1
Red onion, grated - 1/2
Garlic, grated - 2 cloves
Chopped parsley - 1/2 cup
Pinch of chilli flakes
Cumin - 1/2 tsp
Eggs - 2
Self-raising flour - 1/2 cup
Salt - 1/2 tsp
Crumbled feta - 100 g
Oil to cook

Method

- Into a large bowl mix together the kumara, carrot, onion, garlic, parsley, chilli flakes, cumin, eggs, flour, salt and feta.
- Heat a little oil in a frying pan. Add a large tablespoon of mixture to the pan, cooking a few at a time for 3 or 4 minutes on each side. Remove and continue to cook the remainder.
- Serve warm with a salad or rice.



Chocolate Mousse Tarts

Ingredients

Dark chocolate - 250 g
Butter - 20 g
Eggs, separated - 2
Caster sugar - 1/4 cup
Cream - 1 cup
Easter eggs to decorate



Method

- Place a heat-proof bowl over a pot of shallow, simmering water, ensuring the bowl does not touch the water. Add 150g of the chocolate to the bowl, stirring until completely melted and smooth.
- Place a spoonful of the melted chocolate into six paper muffin cases, spreading it around evenly to cover the sides and bottom. Place the cases into the fridge to set.
- Place a clean heat-proof bowl over a pot of shallow, simmering water again. Place the remaining chocolate and butter into the bowl, and mix until melted and smooth. Remove from the heat and cool for 15 minutes.
- In a separate bowl, whisk the egg yolks with the sugar until light and creamy. Fold through the cooled chocolate and butter mix.
- Remove the paper carefully from the chocolate case tarts and place them onto a flat plate or tray.
- Whisk the egg white until just stiff and fold through the chocolate mixture, then fold in the lightly whipped cream. Spoon the mixture evenly into the chocolate tart cases. Place back into the fridge for at least four hours or until firm.
- Decorate with your favourite colourful Easter eggs.

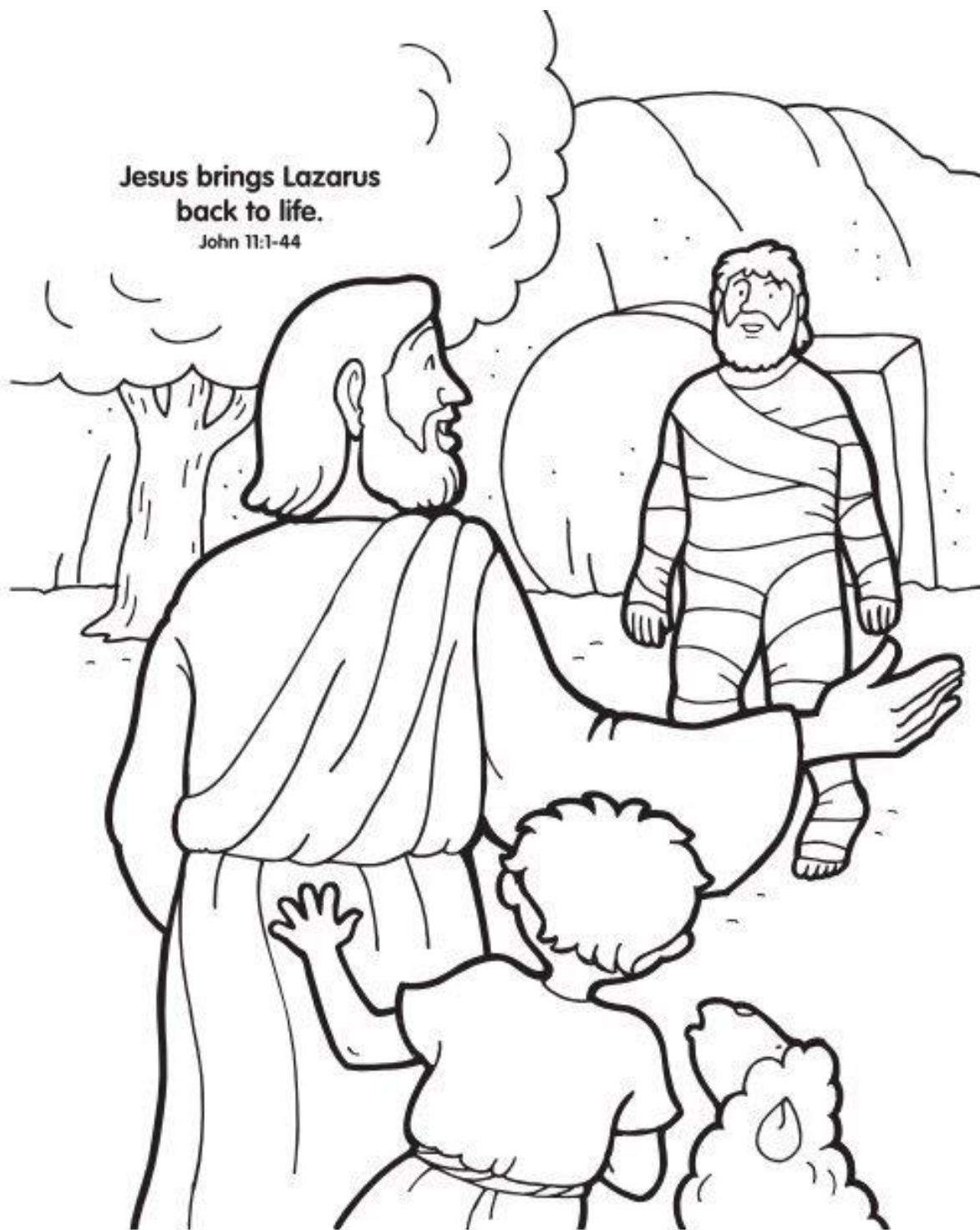
