Index volume, red leather, 47 cm x 31.5 cm. Dated as a Lenihan item from fact that some remnants of items remain (dockets or receipts) pasted into book dating from 1900 and 1901. Index entries suggest household accounts. May tie up with LEN 9-4.

LEN 13

Accounts: Diocesan - Darby Foundation, 1901

Framed deed, 32 cm x 41.2 cm, dated 20 July 1901, between Patrick Darby of Ponsonby and Bishop Lenihan (and his successors) re weekly Mass in perpetuity for the intentions of the said Patrick Darby.

Note:...Bishop Lenihan tended not to distinguish between diocesan accounts, St Patrick's accounts and his own personal accounts. All cash books, ledgers, cheque butts, receipt books &c containing some diocesan accounts have therefore been classified as diocesan accounts, but these sometimes contain also some St Patrick's accounts and other parish accounts as well as the bishop's personal expenses.
