No file or even a whole issue of the Advocate, an Auckland paper, is known to survive, though some cuttings in H probably derive from this paper. It is not known when the paper commenced publication nor for how long it continued, nor even whether it was in fact an official diocesan publication but see editorial comment, P. 6. re articles in N.Z. Tablet during June and July: 'We have no concern with the charges against the late Freeman's Journal, which did not always faithfully represent us.... we had nothing in common with the late Freeman's Journal, nor have we risen from its ashes.'

From list of contents on P. 6, this issue apparently ran to 12 pages.
