Pastoral Letter, Auckland, February 20th, 1881, Walter Steins, S.J. Archbishop, Bishop of Auckland, Printed at the New Zealand Freeman's Journal, General Printing Office, Wyndham Street Auckland.

STE 1-3 Diocesan Accounts, 1879-1882

First entry reads: 'The Rev F Downey took possession of St Francis' Church Newton & on the first Sunday Feb 15 Received the following' Entries from Feb 22 to Aug 15 follow. year not specified, except in pencil in another hand. Two pages of entries at front of book, and two pages of pencilled calculations at back.

STE 1-5 Agreement with Benedictines, 1879

(1) Nueva Zelanda Pro-memoria: agreement between Archbishop Steins, and the Benedictine Abbot General, signed at Subiaco, 30 del Mese di Agosto 1879, re Benedictine monks for Diocese of Auckland.

One sheet, folded, with holes punched, signed D. Raffaele Testa O.S.B., Abate Genle. + Walter Steins S.J. Archiepi. Ep Aucklandensis.

Also, copy and translation, by A.M. Sullivan O.S.B., of true copy, signed by Abbot General at Subiaco 17 September 1879. Large folio sheet, folded, with many punched holes.
