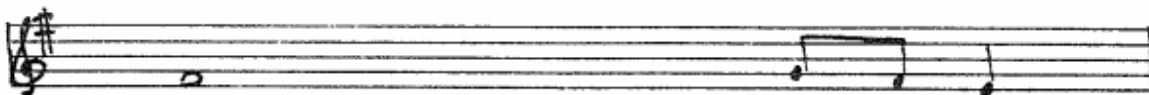

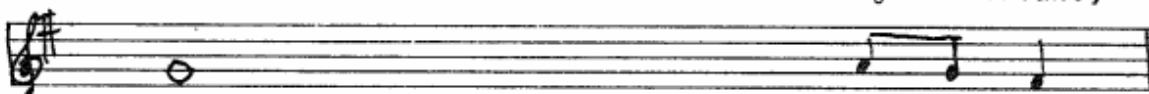

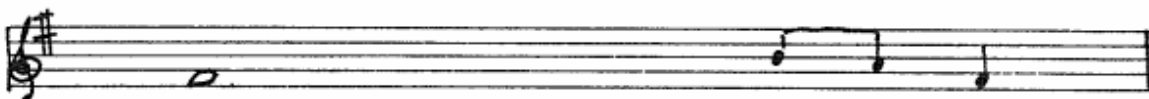
Fa - ther, I put my life in your hands -



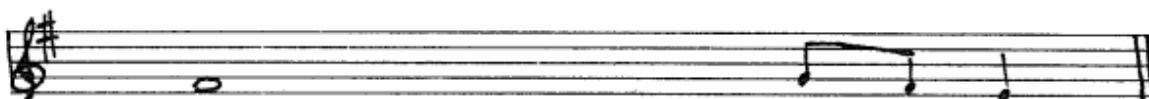
1. In you, O Lord, I take refuge,
