[A pure heart create for me O God.]

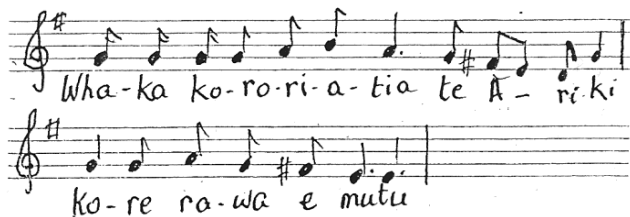

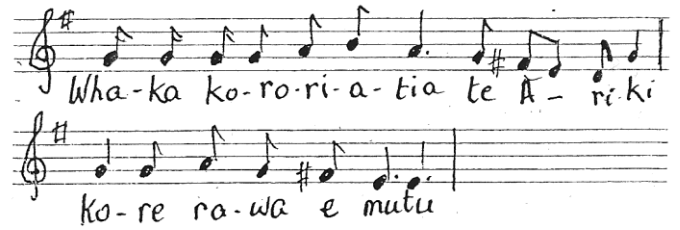
