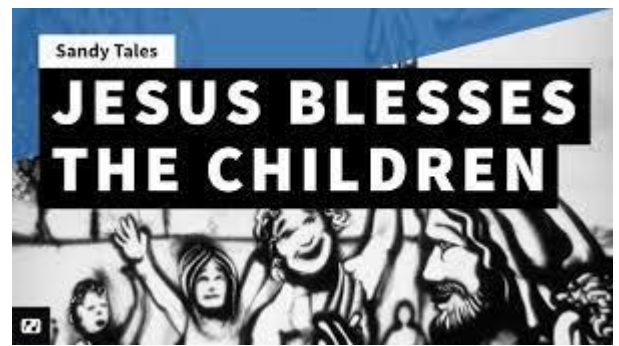

and blessed them.



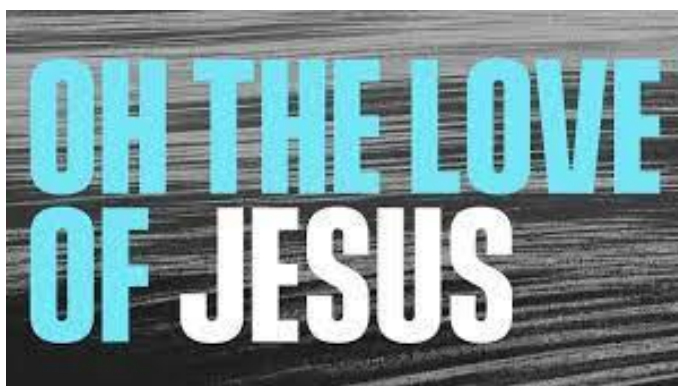

Easy fried rice recipe

Ingredients

- 1 cup Coles Long Grain White Rice
- 2 tsp vegetable oil
- 2 eggs, lightly whisked
- 2 bacon rashers, chopped
- 1 carrot, peeled and grated
- 2 shallots, trimmed, finely sliced
- 1/2 cup frozen peas, thawed
- 1 tbsp soy sauce
- Sesame seeds, to serve
- Shallots, sliced, extra, to serve

Method

- Cook the rice in a large saucepan of boiling water for 12 minutes or until tender. Drain and leave to cool.
-
- Heat oil in non-stick wok or large frying pan over medium heat. Add eggs. Swirl over base to form an omelette. Cook for 2 minutes or until set. Transfer to a chopping board. Set aside to cool slightly. Roll up and thickly slice.
- Add bacon to wok. Cook 4 minutes until light golden. Add carrot. Stir fry 1 minute. Add shallots, peas and rice. Cook, stirring, 3-4 minutes. Add egg and soy sauce. Stir until heated through. Sprinkle with sesame seeds and top with extra shallots. Serve immediately.

Orange Pound Cake

Ingredients

- 3 large eggs
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup (160g) caster sugar
- 1 $\frac{1}{3}$ cup (160g) all-purpose flour, sifted
- $\frac{3}{4}$ teaspoon baking powder
- $\frac{2}{3}$ cup (150g) salted butter, melted
- 1 orange (juice + zest)

Instructions

1. Preheat the oven to 350°F (180°C) and grease a 10 x 4.5-inch (25×10 cm) loaf tin.
2. In a large bowl, whisk the eggs and sugar until pale and fluffy.
3. Sift in the flour with the baking powder, stirring well.
4. Add the melted butter, orange juice and zest, and stir well.
5. Pour the batter into the loaf tin and bake for 40 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted in the centre comes out clean. Allow the pound cake to cool completely before serving.
