Cheesy Tomato Pasta

Ingredients

- Pumpkin, cut into chunks - 200 g
- Carrots, cut into chunks - 2
- Kumara, cut into chunks - 200 g
- Wholemeal penne - 250 g
- Olive oil - 1 Tbsp
- Garlic cloves, crushed - 2
- Button mushrooms, sliced - 2 cups
- Spinach - 1 cup
- Chopped tomatoes - 400 g
- Handful fresh oregano, chopped
- Handful fresh basil leaves, chopped
- Shredded light edam cheese - 1 1/2 cups



Method

- Steam pumpkin, carrot and sweet potato over a pot of boiling water for 15 minutes or until tender. Place in a blender, blitz until smooth and set aside.
- Cook pasta according to packet instructions. Set aside.
- Heat oil in a large saucepan over medium heat and sauté garlic for 1-2 minutes. Add mushrooms and spinach and sauté for a further 2 minutes or until spinach is wilted and mushrooms are tender.
- Add tomatoes and stir to combine. Cook for 2 minutes to thicken slightly. Stir in vegetable purée and herbs.
- Divide pasta among serving bowls and top with pasta sauce and cheese.

Fruit Sponge

Ingredients

2 cups hot stewed fruit e.g apples, boysenberries, apricots, sweetened to taste

125g butter

½ tsp vanilla essence

½ cup white sugar

2 eggs

1 cup standard grade flour

2 tsp baking powder

2 Tbsp milk

Icing sugar



Method

- Preheat the oven to 190°C.
- Place the sweetened stewed fruit in an ovenproof dish, cover and keep hot while you make the sponge topping.
- Put the butter, vanilla and sugar into a bowl and beat hard until pale and creamy.
- Beat in the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition. Sift on the flour and baking powder and fold into the mixture, followed by the milk. Spoon the sponge mixture over the fruit.
- Bake for 40 minutes or until the sponge springs back when lightly touched. Serve hot dusted with icing sugar
