He stood up to read and was handed a scroll of the prophet Isaiah.

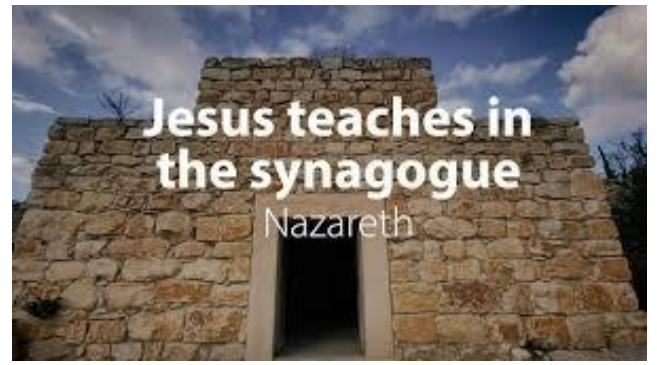
He unrolled the scroll and found the passage where it was written:

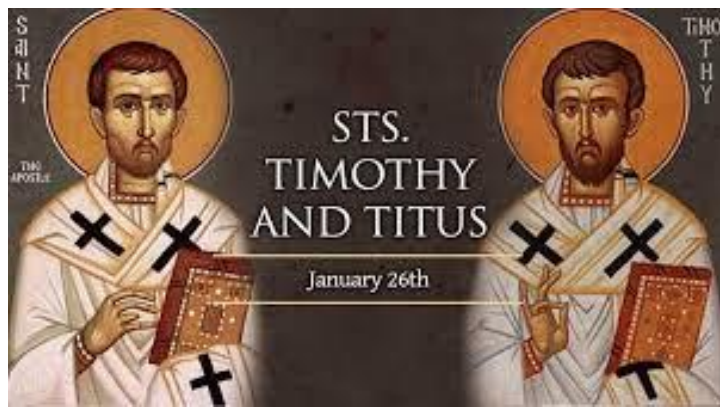
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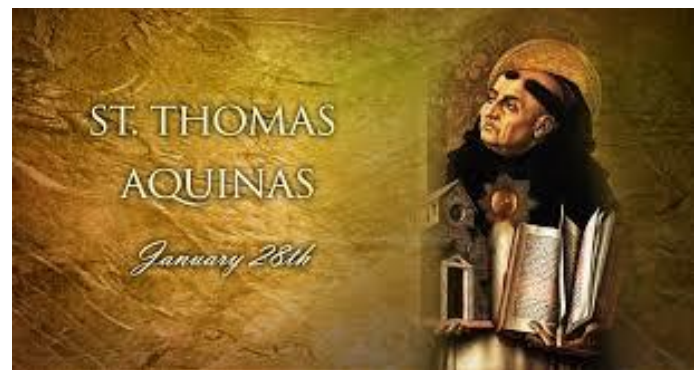

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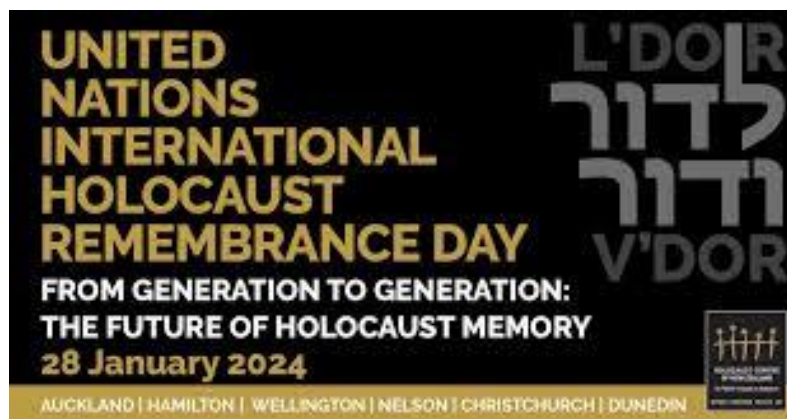

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# Easy chicken vegetable bake

## Ingredients

2 large Potatoes, peeled and finely sliced

500 g Chicken thighs, boneless and skinless, cut into 3cm pieces

1 Onion, peeled and finely diced

1 cup Grated pumpkin

2-3 cups Wattie's frozen chunky mix vegetables

420 g Can Wattie's condensed creamy chicken soup

2 tbsp Chopped fresh parsley

1/4 cup Grated cheese

1/4 cup Fresh breadcrumbs



## Instructions

- Preheat oven to 180°C (fan bake).
- Place the sliced potatoes in an overlapping layer in the base of a lasagne-style dish.
- In a bowl, mix together the chicken, onion, grated pumpkin, Wattie's frozen Chunky Mix Vegetables, Wattie's Condensed Creamy Chicken Soup and parsley.
- Spread the mixture evenly over the potatoes
- Sprinkle with the breadcrumbs and cheese.
- Bake for 1 - 1 ¼ hours or until chicken is cooked through.



# Lamingtons

## Ingredients

225 g Pre-made sponge cake

### For Chocolate Lamingtons:

1 cup Icing sugar

1 cup Cocoa

1 cup Coconut

### For Pink Lamingtons:

85 g Pkt Gregg's raspberry jelly

1 cup Boiling water

1 cup Coconut



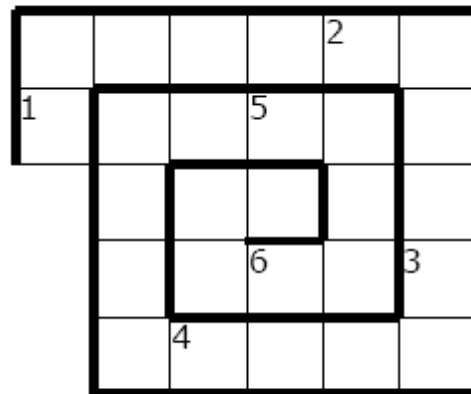
## Instructions

- Cut sponge into 12 pieces.
- To make chocolate lamingtons, sift the icing sugar and cocoa together and add enough water to make runny icing. Place this in a shallow dish.
- To make pink lamingtons, make up the jelly with the boiling water and set aside to cool. When cool but not set, pour into a shallow dish.
- In another dish, sprinkle some coconut. Top up the dish with extra coconut as required to keep it clean and white.
- Dip each sponge piece firstly into the chocolate icing or jelly and coat thoroughly, then coat in the coconut. Set aside until set.
- Serve as they are or with a dollop of whipped cream and a drop of raspberry jam.

The people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law. Mark 1:22

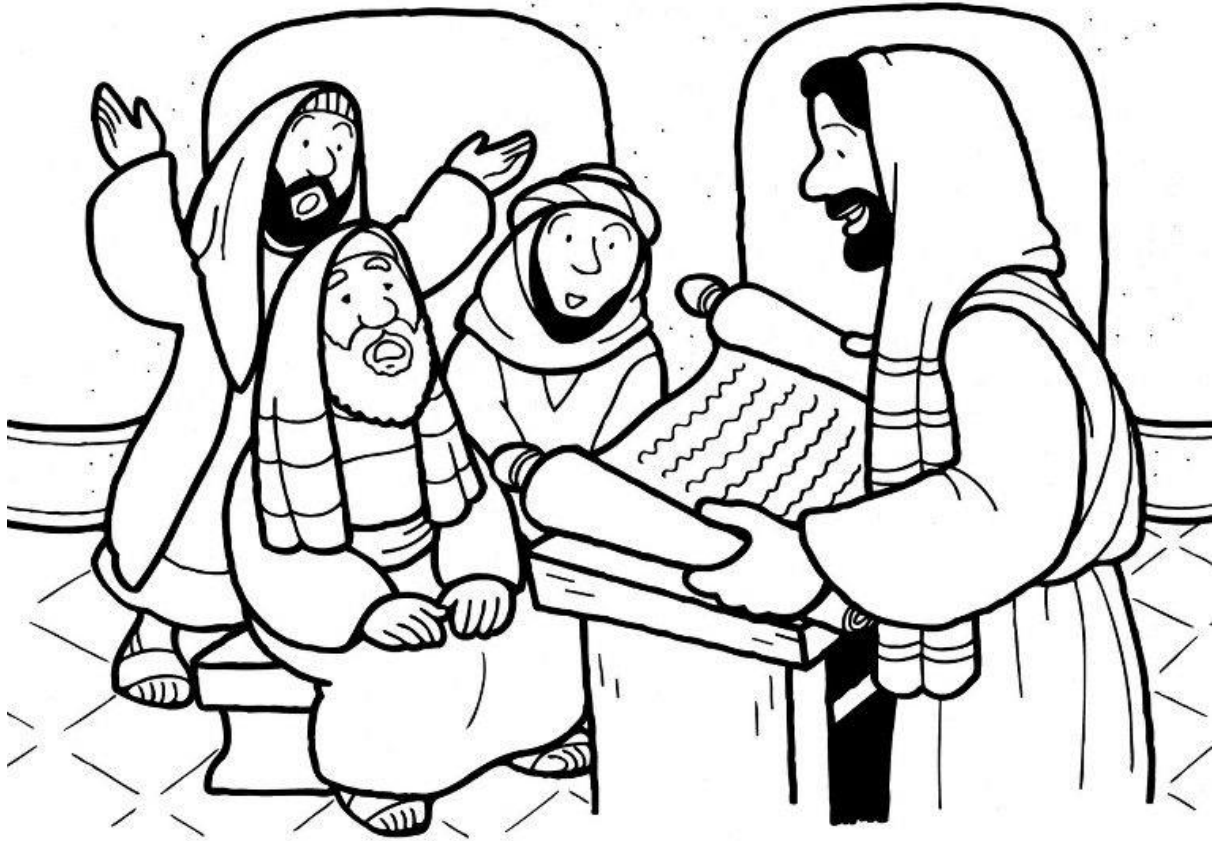
