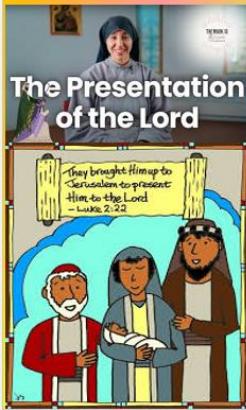

He was filled with the wisdom and grace of God



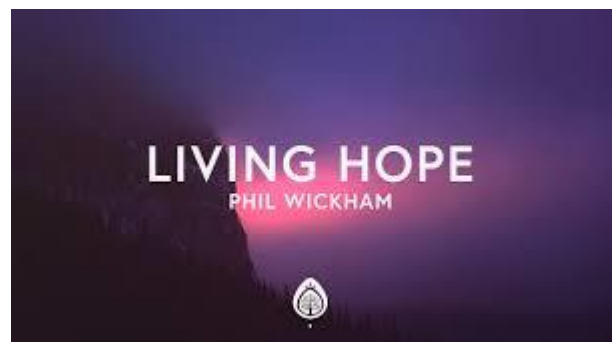

Zucchini & Corn Fritters with Avocado Lime Crema

Ingredients

Fritter batter

Zucchini - 3 medium
Corn kernels, fresh or canned - 1 cup
Red onion, diced - 1/2
Eggs - 2
All purpose flour - 1/2 cup
Baking powder - 1 tsp
Parmesan cheese - 1/4 cup
Handful of coriander, chopped
Salt to taste
Pepper to taste
Olive oil
Avocado lime crema

Avocados - 2
Thick Greek yoghurt - 1/2
Fresh coriander - 1/8 cup
Lime juice - 2 Tbsp
Jalapenos (ones from jar) - 6-8
Garlic - 2 cloves
Salt to taste
Pepper to taste



Method

- Grate zucchini and leave in a clean tea towel. Wait 15 mins then squeeze out excess liquid until there's none left.
- In a separate bowl add the corn, diced red onion, 2 eggs, parmesan and coriander.
- Add zucchini to corn mix, then add dry ingredients. Season the fritter mix with a good amount of salt and pepper.
- Place all ingredients for the crema in a food processor and blitz until smooth.
- Heat up a fry pan with olive oil and cook fritters for 5 mins each side or until they are crispy and golden and the centre is cooked.
- Transfer the avocado lime crema to a piping bag for serving.

Apple & Mandarin Custard Cake

Ingredients

Butter, softened - 150 g

Caster sugar - 1/2 cup

Eggs - 3

Vanilla - 1 tsp

Natural yoghurt - 1 cup

Self-rising flour - 1 1/2 cups

Mandarins, zested and cut into wedges - 2

Granny smith apples, peeled and sliced - 3

Custard - 1 cup

Sliced almonds - 1 Tbsp



Method

- Preheat the oven to 170°C (150°C fan-forced). Line a 23cm tin with paper.
- Cream the butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add the eggs one at a time, and vanilla. Stir through the yoghurt, flour and mandarin zest.
- Spread half the batter into the base of the tin. Top with the sliced apple and mandarin wedges. Spread over the custard and top with the remaining batter. Sprinkle it with the almonds.
- Bake in the centre of the oven for 50 minutes until soft to the touch in the centre.
- Remove and cool completely. Serve!
