



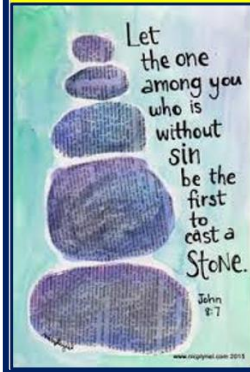

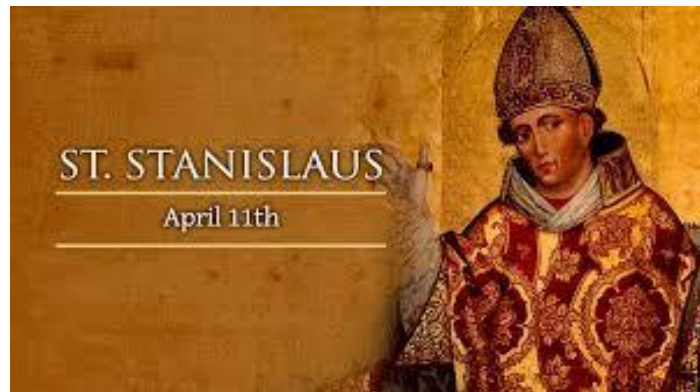

Pumpkin & Chicken Pasta Bake

Ingredients

- Butternut pumpkin, peeled and sliced into 1/2cm pieces - 600 g
- Olive oil - 3 Tbsp
- Paprika - 1/2 tsp
- Onion, sliced - 1/2
- Garlic, crushed - 2 cloves
- chicken breast and cut into 2cm cubes - 440 g
- Creamy Pumpkin Soup - 500 ml
- Spinach - 2 cups
- spiral pasta, cooked - 200 g
- Grated cheese - 1/2 cup
- Basil leaves (optional) - 1/2 cup



Method

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C (160°C fan forced).
2. Place the pumpkin onto a lined baking tray. Rub with 2 tablespoons of oil and sprinkle over the paprika. Bake for 20 minutes until lightly browned.
3. While the pumpkin cooks, heat the remaining oil in a large frying pan. Add the onion and garlic cooking for 2 minutes. Stir through the chicken pieces browning lightly on all sides. Pour in the soup, bringing it to a simmer for 5 minutes. Remove from the heat, stir through half the cheese, and cooked pasta and fold through the spinach.
4. Pour the mix into a large baking dish, nestle the slices of pumpkin, sprinkle with remaining cheese and bake for 15 minutes.
5. Serve hot with a few basil leaves.

Easy Apple Slice

Ingredients

- 1 can of apple slices, drained (385g)
- 2 cups self-raising flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 125g butter, melted
- 1 Egg

Optional extra spices

- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1 tsp all spice

Instructions

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C fan bake
2. In a large bowl mix together apples, flour, sugar and spices if using.
3. Add the melted butter and egg then stir until well combined.
4. Spread the mixture evenly into a lined baking tray.
5. Sprinkle the top with 2 tablespoons of sugar.
6. Bake for 35-45 minutes or until golden and a skewer comes out clean.
7. Let the slice cool in the tin then slice into large pieces.
8. Store in an airtight container in a cool dark place.

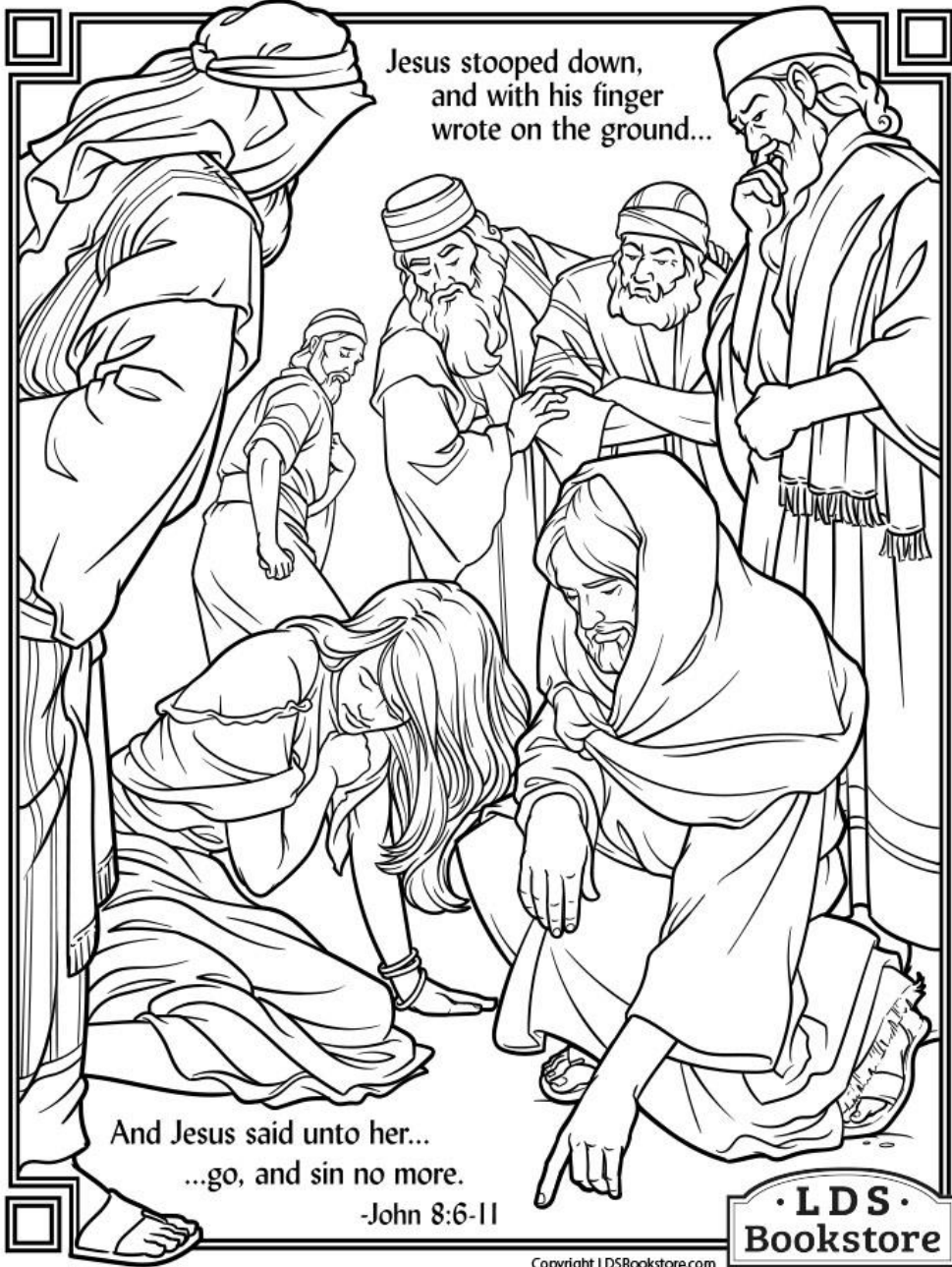
Pointing Fingers & Throwing Stones
